PROGRAMMES

The University follows a fully residential academic model, combining resident faculty with visiting scholars from leading national and international institutions. Its academic programmes foster intellectual curiosity, interdisciplinary learning, and research engagement, including opportunities during academic breaks.

The Undergraduate (UG) Programmes offered are of a five-year duration following a semester system. The Postgraduate (PG) Programmes offered are of a one-year duration from the upcoming academic session 2027-28*.



POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

NLU Meg currently offers the following Post Graduate Programme

- **Master of Laws (LL.M.)**

The University offers a one-year* residential postgraduate programme in Law, designed to promote advanced legal learning, critical inquiry, research and specialised understanding of contemporary legal issues.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

NLU Meg presents students with a diverse array of three Undergraduate Degree Programmes:

- **Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws [B.A. LL.B. (Hons.)]**
- **Bachelor of Business Administration and Bachelor of Laws [B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons.)]**
- **Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Laws [B.Sc. LL.B. (Hons.)]**

The undergraduate programmes are governed by the Academic & Examination Regulations 2026 and follow the prescribed curriculum, credit requirements and academic progression framework of the University.

Students must accumulate credits across these specific subject categories:

- Compulsory Law Papers
- Major Papers (social science, management, or science streams, depending on the programme)
- Minor Papers
- Elective Courses
- Value Added Courses
- Clinical and Practical Papers
- Honours Specialisation Papers and Dissertation

Students opting for Honours must complete eight specialised papers and a dissertation from (Semesters VII to X).

RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES

The research framework at The National Law University of Meghalaya (NLU Meg) promotes a multifaceted approach that brings together theoretical inquiry, interdisciplinary perspectives, and practical engagement. With a strong emphasis on research, the University fosters innovation, critical thinking, academic excellence, and a culture of scholarly inquiry, enabling students and researchers to engage meaningfully with emerging legal, technological, and societal challenges.

The University offers the **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.)** programme which is a fully funded, residential doctoral programme supported through various funding agencies, domicile governments, and the University, providing scholars with an environment conducive to advanced research and academic development.

The University also provides opportunities for scholars and researchers to engage in research activities through a range of funded research projects, supported either by the University or by external funding agencies. These projects provide an opportunity to contribute to focused areas of research, undertake scholarly investigations, and engage with contemporary and emerging issues across law and related disciplines.

Research Fellows and **Post-Doctoral Fellows** may be appointed under such projects based on the nature and requirements of the research undertaken. Such appointments shall be subject to the eligibility criteria, terms and conditions, duration of the project, and other requirements prescribed by the University or the respective funding agency, as may be applicable from time to time.

ADMISSIONS 2027–28

Applicants seeking admission to the undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) law courses at The National Law University of Meghalaya must register for the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2027.

NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY MEGHALAYA

The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) is a premier national-level entrance examination facilitating admissions across 26 National Law Universities in India, including NLU Meghalaya.

- All seat allocations are governed by the University's prevailing reservation policy.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CLAT 2027 Undergraduate (UG) Syllabus

A 2-hour test, 120 multiple-choice questions carrying 1 mark each. There shall be negative marking of 0.25 marks for every wrong answer. These questions would be divided across the following 5 subjects:

- **English Language**
- **Current Affairs & GK**
- **Legal Reasoning**
- **Logical Reasoning**
- **Quantitative Techniques**

CLAT 2027 Postgraduate (PG) Syllabus

A 2-hour test, 120 multiple-choice questions carrying 1 mark each. There shall be negative marking of 0.25 marks for every wrong answer. The paper will cover core undergraduate law subjects, including **Constitutional Law, Jurisprudence, Administrative Law, Contract, Torts, Family Law, Criminal Law, Property Law, Company Law, Public International Law, Tax Law, Environmental Law, and Labour & Industrial Law.**

Questions will be based on extracts from judgments, statutes and regulations, testing candidates' ability to comprehend, identify legal issues, summarise passages, and apply legal principles.

UG Eligibility to apply for 5-Year Integrated LL.B. programme

- Qualification: Passed or appearing for 10+2 (Class 12) or equivalent examination.
- Forty five percent (45%) of marks or its equivalent in grade or
- Forty Percent (40%) of marks or equivalent in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwD categories.
- Age Limit: No upper age limit.

PG Eligibility to apply for LL.M. programme

- Qualification: An LL.B. degree or an equivalent examination.
- Fifty percent (50%) marks or its equivalent grade;
- Forty-Five percent (45%) marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwD categories
- Age Limit: No upper age limit.

Appearing Candidates: Students taking their qualifying exams in March/April 2027 are eligible to apply.
